Increase Available Food

- New refrigerators for perishable products to be stored at partner agencies
- Warehouse equipment (forklift, pallet jack, scissor lift) for food safety and storage
- Small tools (gloves, rakes, pruners) for our community farm
- Fertilizer, seeds and plants for our community farm
- Funding toward a produce match for low-income families, doubling their buying power
- Funding or donations of staple food items (peanut butter, beans, rice) for ongoing needs

Supplies and Materials

- Reusable bags for shoppers

Support our School Pantry program
