Grant Eligibility

Eligibility

Organization:

- Must be a 501(c)(3) or 509(a) status from the IRS.
- Must be providing services aligned with an Impact 100 Focus Area.

The proposed program or project:

- addresses a defined community need;
- operates for a defined duration;
- has defined, measurable goals;
- provides services in 1 or more counties in the 10-county Tri-State area (Hamilton, Brown, Adams, Clermont, Butler, Warren, Dearborn, Kenton, Campbell, or Boone counties in Ohio, Eastern Indiana, and Northern Kentucky);
- is a capital, start-up, technology, or program expansion project; and
- utilizes the full \$100,000 grant over a 1-3 year period.

Not funded:

- Recent grant recipients (2022-2025)
- Impact 100 does NOT accept grant applications that are for endowments, current operating expenses, partisan activities or programs, completed projects, individual churches, indigent care subsidy, travel, loans, or individuals.
- Funds cannot be regranted to other non-profit organizations.

Strengthen and enhance the lives of children and families.



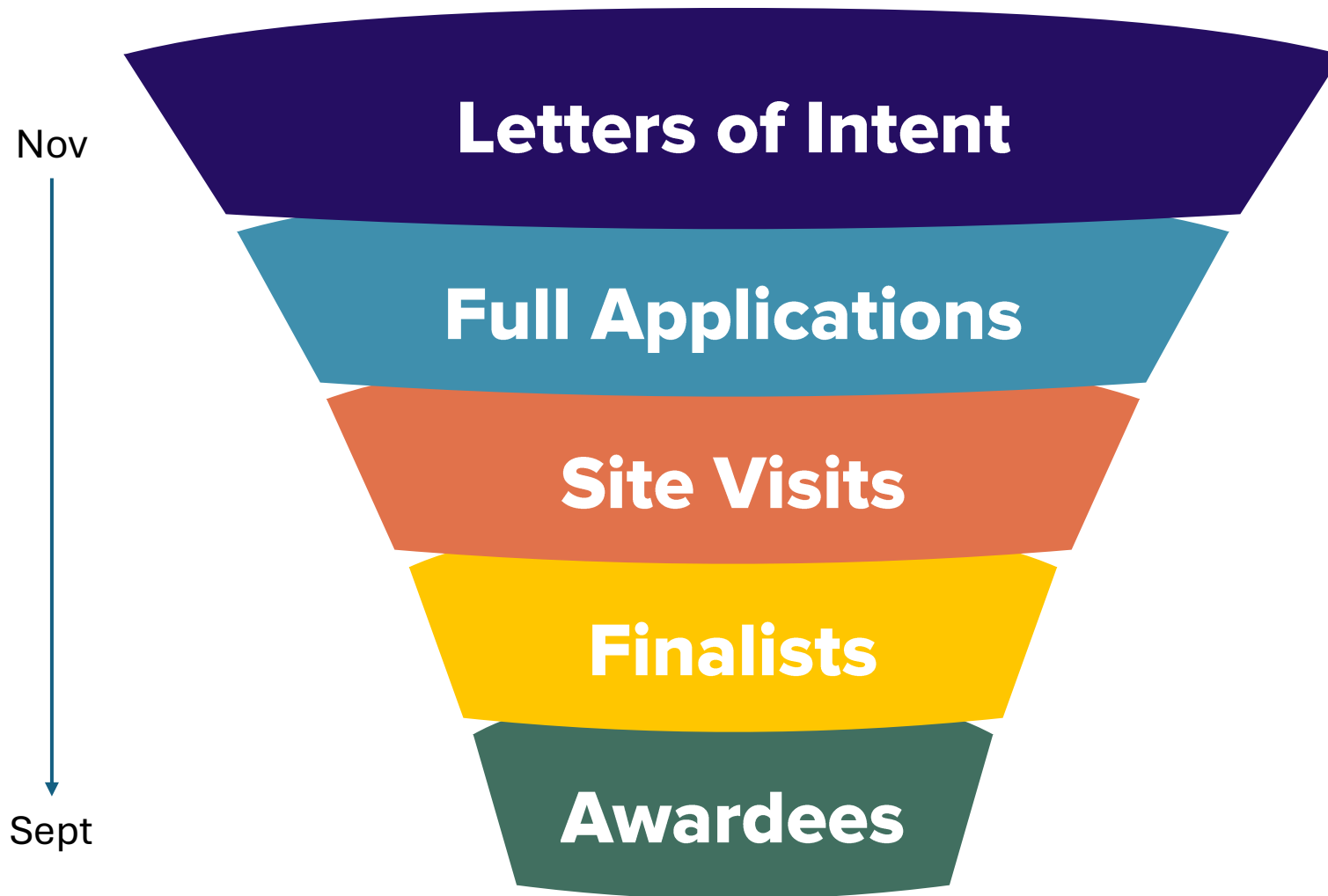

Positively impact the mental or physical health and wellness of people.

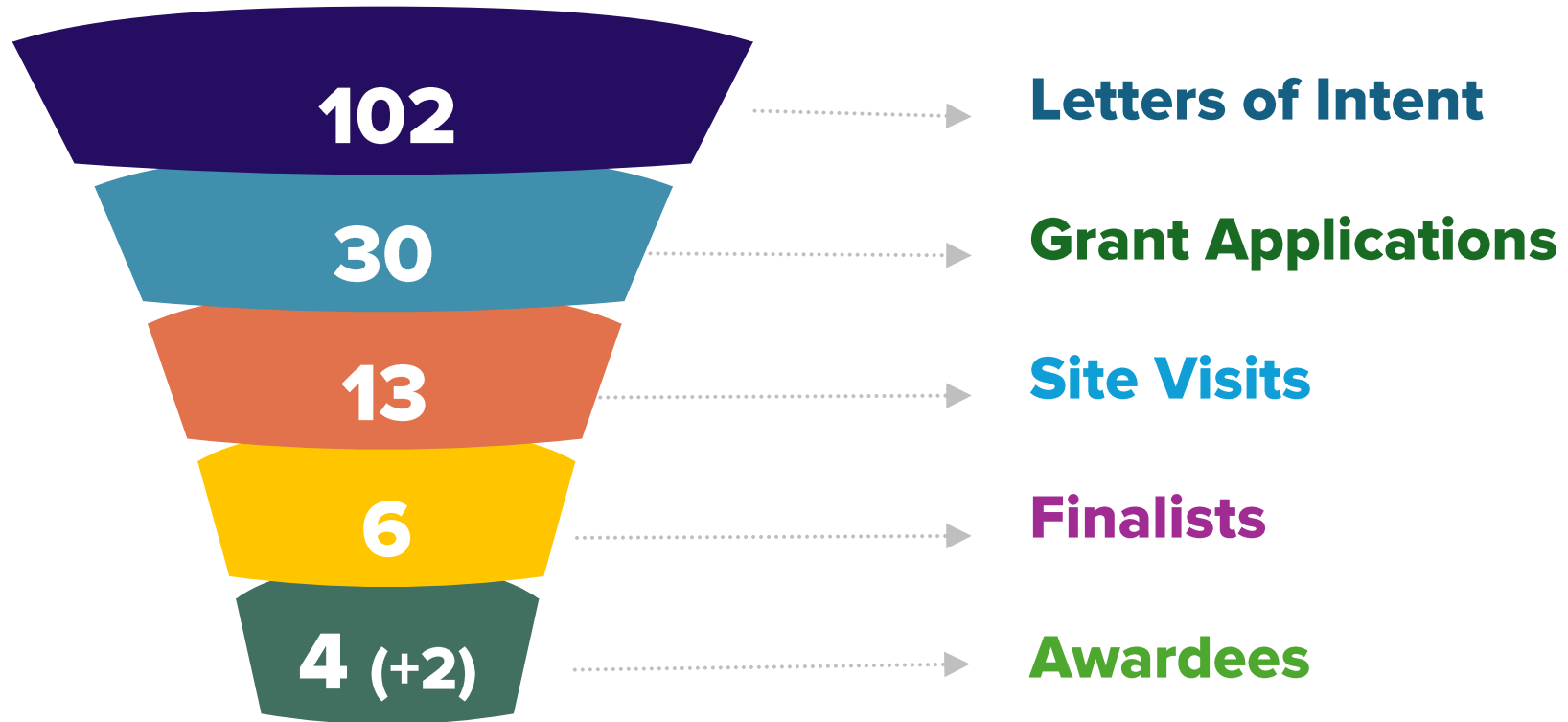

 - 3 years of financial reports (balance sheet and P&L)
 - Audit and 990
 - Current year organization budget
 - Project budget

• Notification: early April • Start: mid-April • End: early May	• Host 5-10 Impact 100 GRT Members for a 1-hour meeting • Answer financial questions from CIRC	• Community Investment Review Committee (CIRC) reviews financials; submits questions to applicants • GRTs conducts site visits; proposes finalist candidates • Board selects and ratifies finalist slate

Financial: Project Budget EXAMPLE

For example, ABC Org is launching a new program and is seeking Impact 100 funds to support the first 3 years of operation. The total expected project budget for those 3 years is \$250,000 (\$50,000 in Y1, \$75,000 in Y2, and \$125,000 in Y3). An Impact 100 grant, if awarded, would provide \$100,000 towards this program launch.

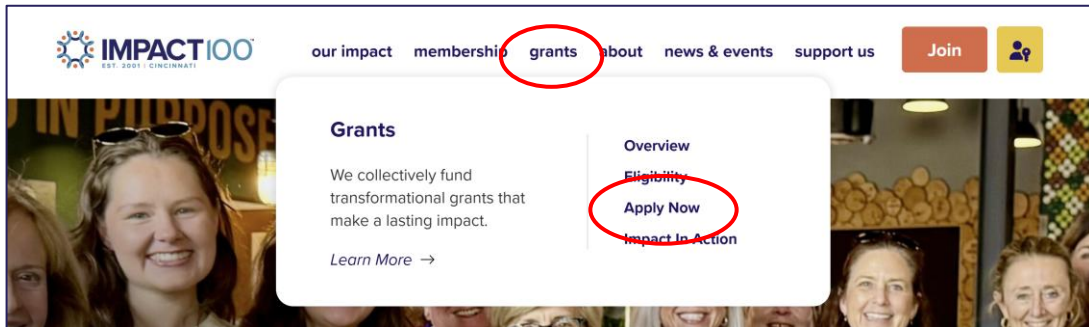

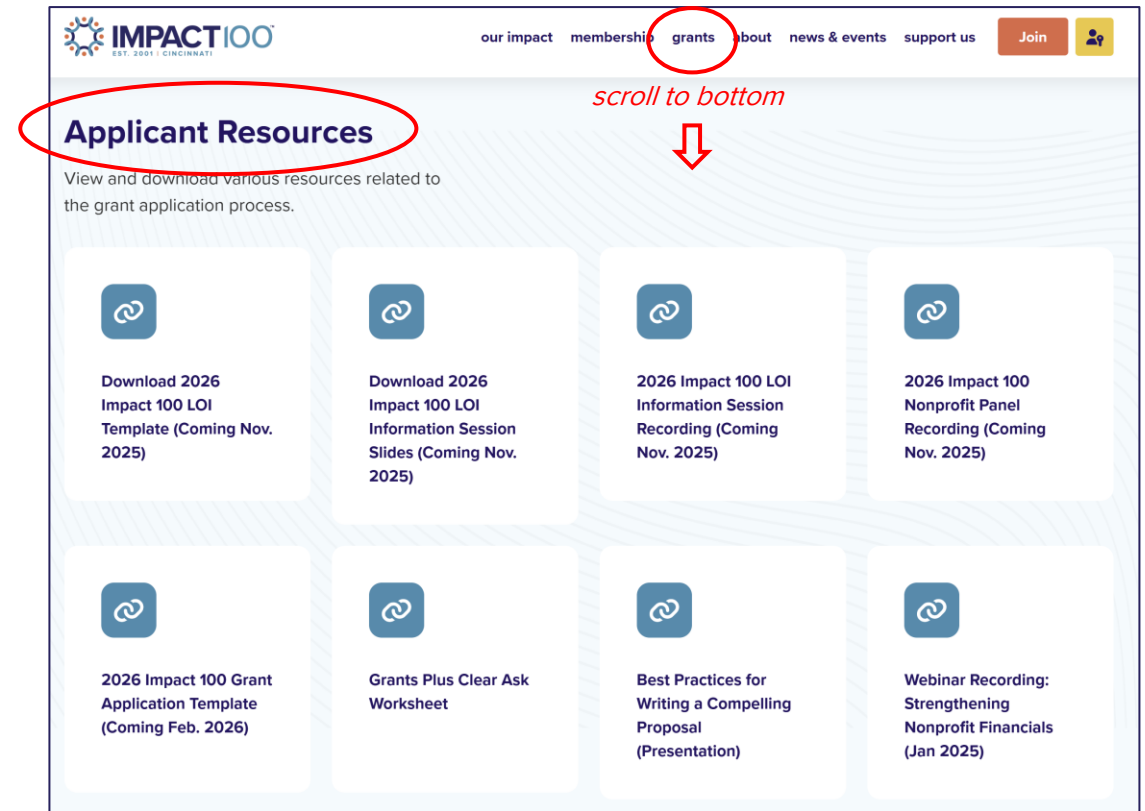

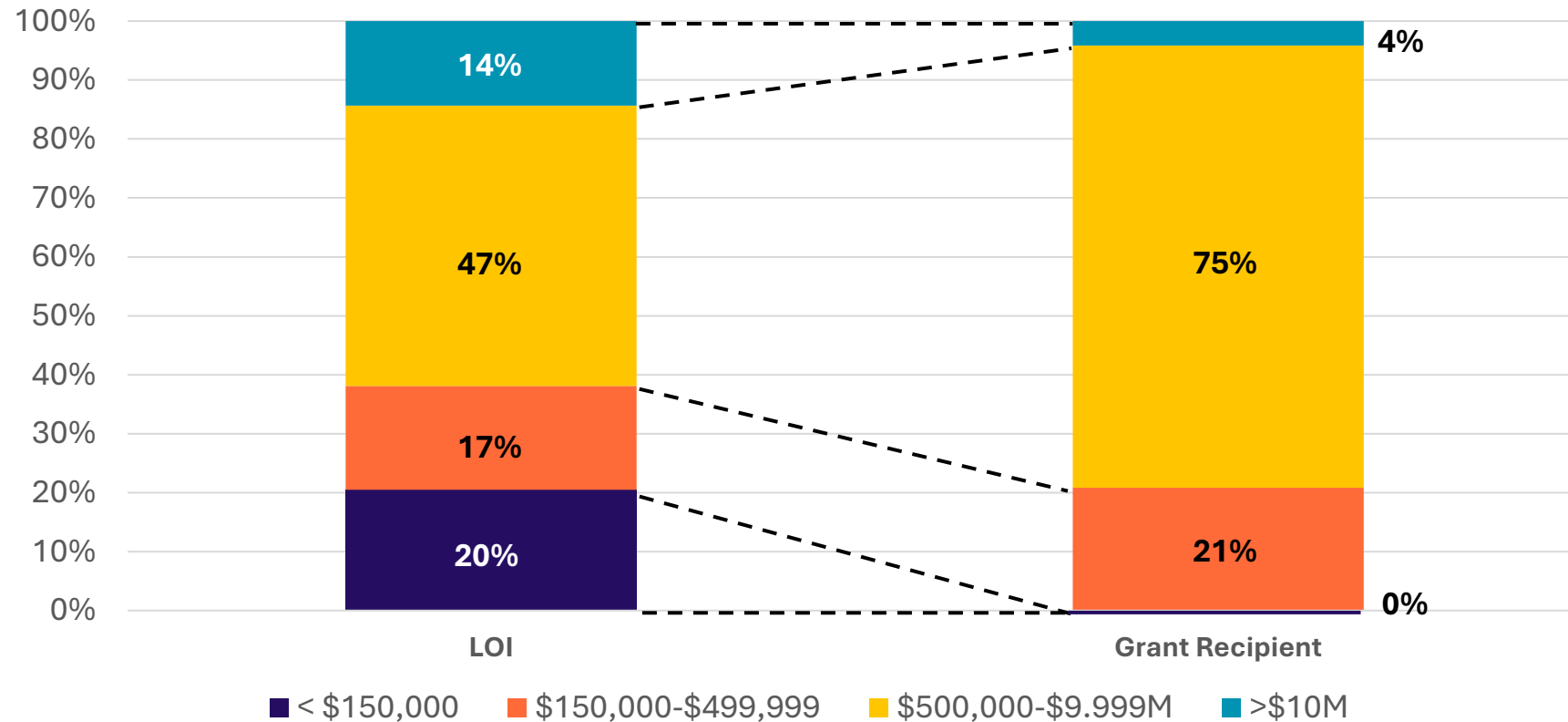

LOI's Receiving Funding by Applicant Budget Size

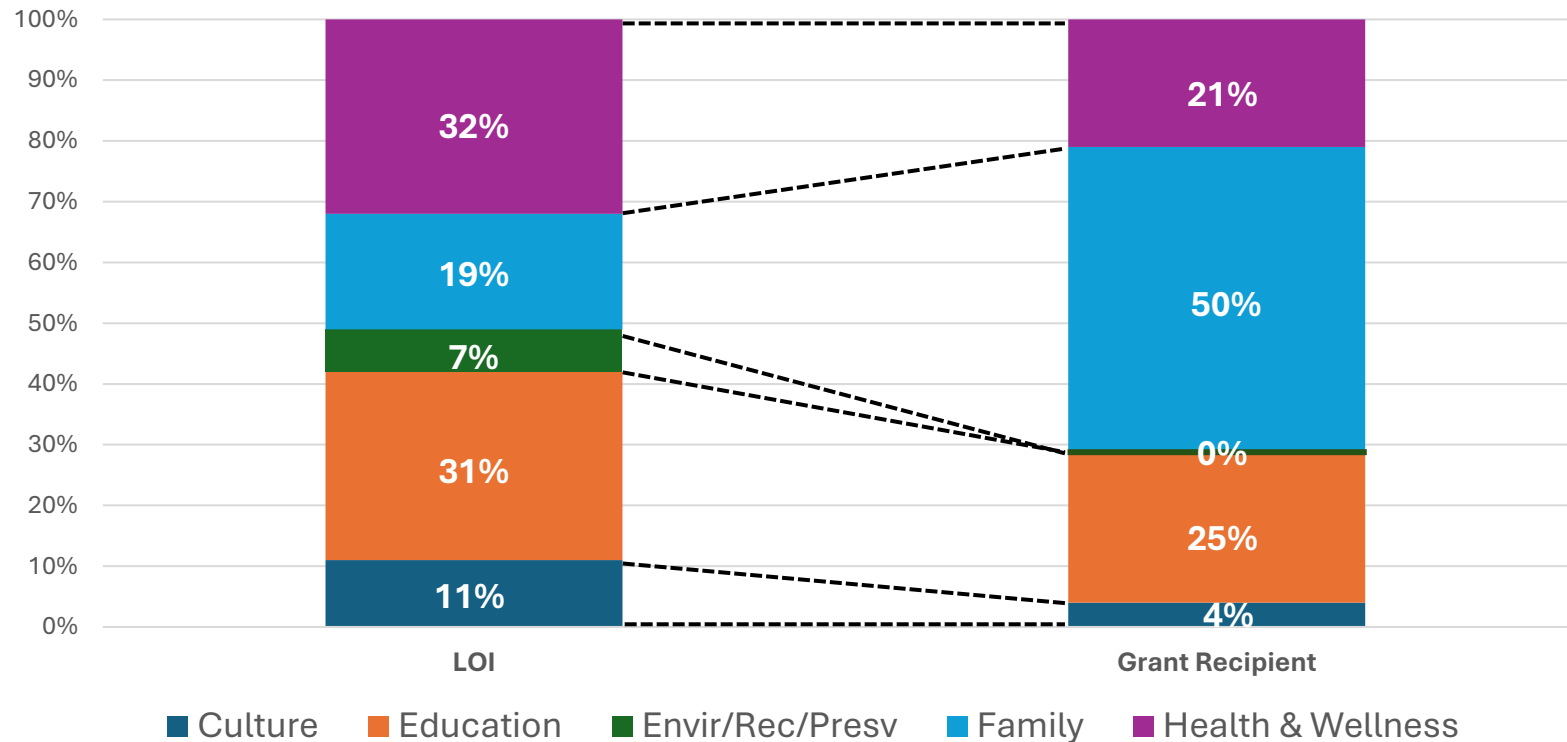


Note: 1.5% of NPs submitting LOIs were of Undetermined size.
