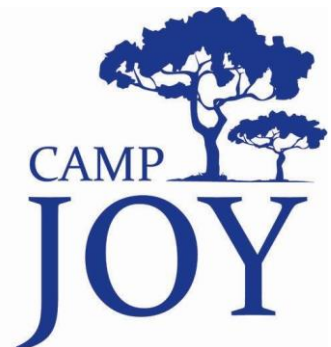

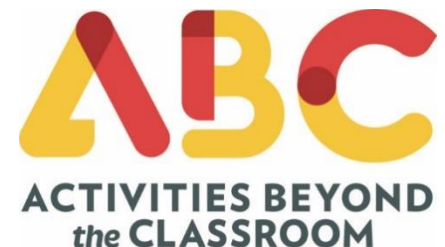

*St. Vincent de Paul Charitable Pharmacy seeks to improve the health and welfare of community residents by providing an innovative, cost-effective, caring response to chronically and temporarily ill individuals with no means of accessing prescription medication.*

## Heal

- Over-the-Counter Medication
  - Aspirin 81mg
  - Calcium, Calcium + D
  - Vitamin D
  - Fluticasone nasal spray
- Medical Supplies
  - Blood pressure monitors
  - Alcohol swabs
  - Lancets
  - Pill splitters
- Prescription Medication\*
  - \$100 provides high blood pressure medication to 1,000 patients
  - \$500 provides insulin to 42 patients with diabetes
  - \$1,000 provides 17 rescue inhalers for patients at risk of asthma attacks
