- **What does it mean to be a Sustaining Member?**

As a Sustaining Member, you make a commitment to continue your Impact 100 membership, year after year.

- **How does it benefit Impact 100?**

Sustaining Members are a core group we can count on through the years, which helps us with long-range planning and the stability of the organization. Your ongoing commitment also saves administrative time and expense, and allows Impact 100 volunteers to focus on growing our membership and grant pool.

- **How does it benefit me?**

You have the satisfaction of a commitment to support our nonprofit community for the long term. Sustaining Members tell us it's nice to "set it and forget it," and you'll skip the membership campaign emails and calls.

- **Can I choose any level of membership?**

You can continue to be a full member (\$1,000), half member (\$500) or 110% member (donating an additional 10% toward administrative and operating expenses). All membership dollars continue to go directly to our grant recipients.

- **Is the commitment binding for a certain amount of time?**

As a Sustaining Member, your membership will continue until you advise us that you wish it to stop.

- **Can I change the amount I want to contribute?**

Once you've become a Sustaining Member, if you wish to change your membership level, send an email to administration@impact100.org. We'll help you process that choice for your membership in the future.

- **How many Sustaining Members does Impact 100 have?**

Currently, we have more than 60 Sustaining Members (approximately 15% of our membership). These committed members help to sustain our mission. Please join this valuable group!

- **How do I become a Sustaining Member?**
