

Evaluation Criteria

Qualities of a strong proposal

Project	Compelling Need? Clear Solution?
Organization	Appropriate? Confident in ability to deliver?
Transformational Impact	New, bold, and/or innovative?
DEI	Proximate to issue and people? Advancing DEI in org and community?
Financial Health	Good stewards of Impact 100 funds?



Eligibility

Organization:

- Must be a 501(c)(3) or 509(a) status from the IRS.
- Must be providing services aligned with an Impact 100 Focus Area.

The proposed program or project:

- addresses a defined community need;
- operates for a defined duration;
- has defined, measurable goals;
- provides services in 1 or more counties in the 10-county Tri-State area (Hamilton, Brown, Adams, Clermont, Butler, Warren, Dearborn, Kenton, Campbell, or Boone counties in Ohio, Eastern Indiana, and Northern Kentucky);
- is a capital, start-up, technology, or program expansion project; and
- utilizes the full \$100,000 grant over a 1-3 year period.

Not funded:

- Recent grant recipients (2020-2023)
- Impact 100 does NOT accept grant applications that are for endowments, current operating expenses, partisan activities or programs, completed projects, individual churches, indigent care subsidy, travel, loans, or individuals.
- Funds cannot be regranted to other non-profit organizations.

Financial: Project Budget

An Impact 100 grant is \$100,000 that can be used over a 1-3-year period starting no earlier than 10/1/24 (can start later). With that in mind ...

- Over what timeframe do you anticipate using the grant?
 - 1 year

- What is the total budget for the project/program over that same timeframe?
- Describe how you anticipate Impact 100 funds being used.
 Describe major categories of spending such as salaries,
 equipment, marketing, construction, etc. (1000 char)
- If the total project/program budget exceeds \$100,000, how will additional funding be secured? (1000 char)




Authorization & Acknowledgements
