



Ohio Justice & Policy Center (OJPC) is a 501(c)3 nonprofit law firm with offices in Cincinnati and Columbus, Ohio. We fight for equal justice and fair treatment in all stages of incarceration, because every person deserves dignity after their conviction and freedom after their sentence.

OJPC proposes to expand its services to provide free legal services and advocacy for incarcerated or formerly incarcerated women, focusing on women who have survived domestic violence and committed or participated in the killing of their abuser in self-defense, have survived human trafficking, or are drug conspiracy offenders pressured into committing crimes. The project will address issues like inadequate mental health care, which affects over two-thirds of incarcerated women, most of whom are mothers and the primary caretakers of their children.
